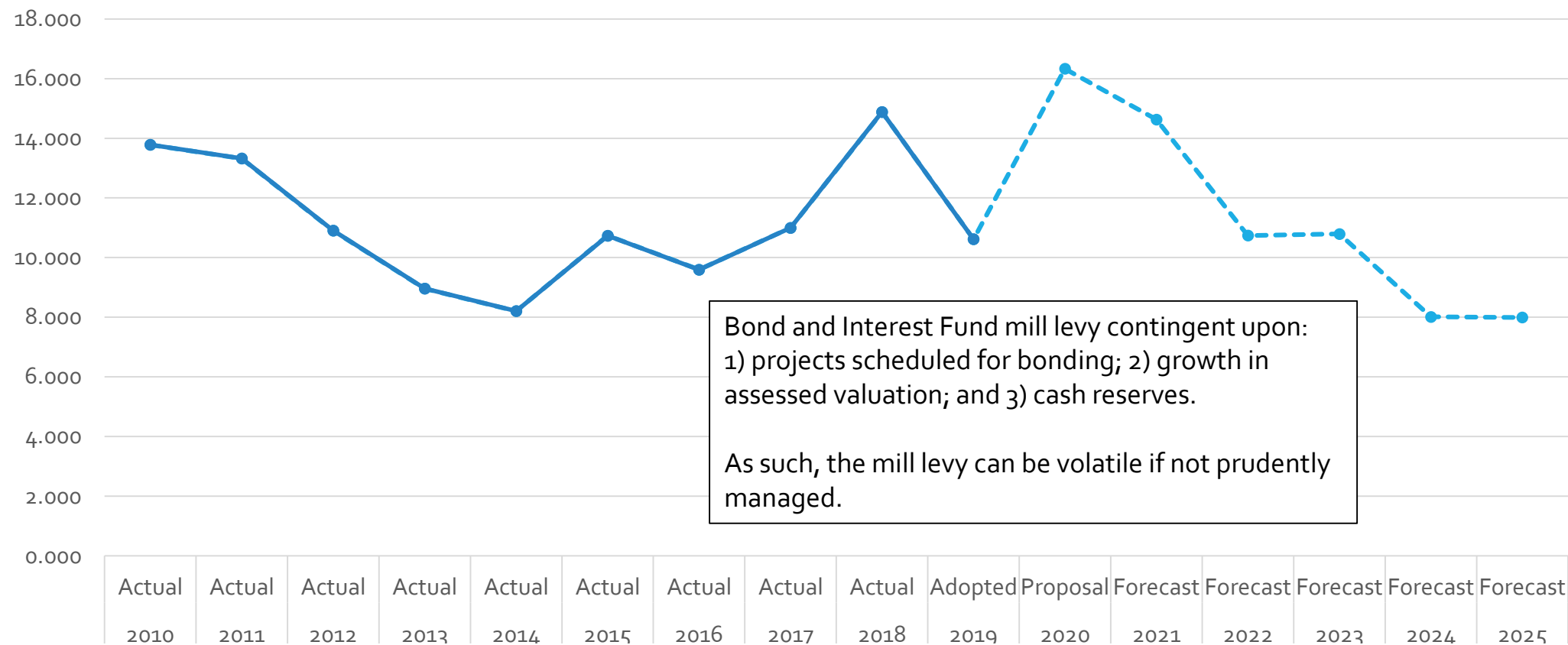

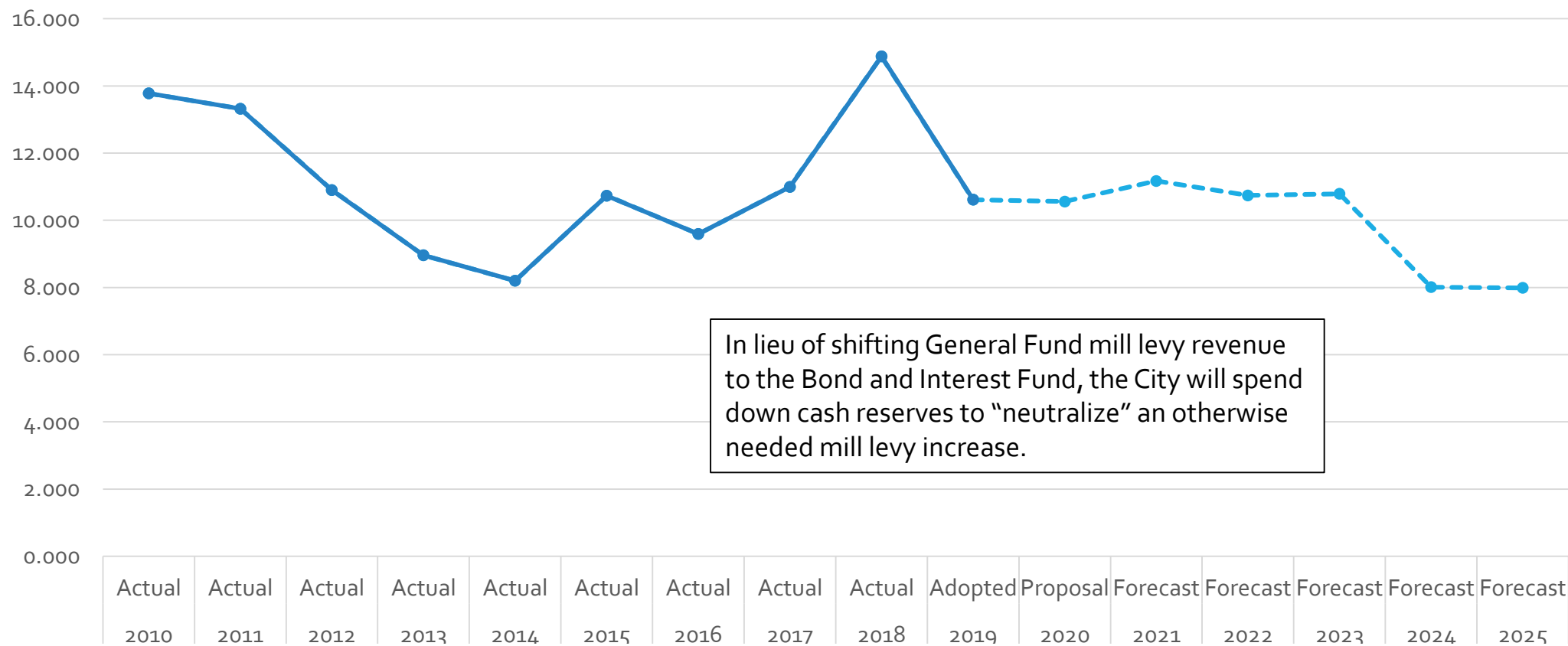

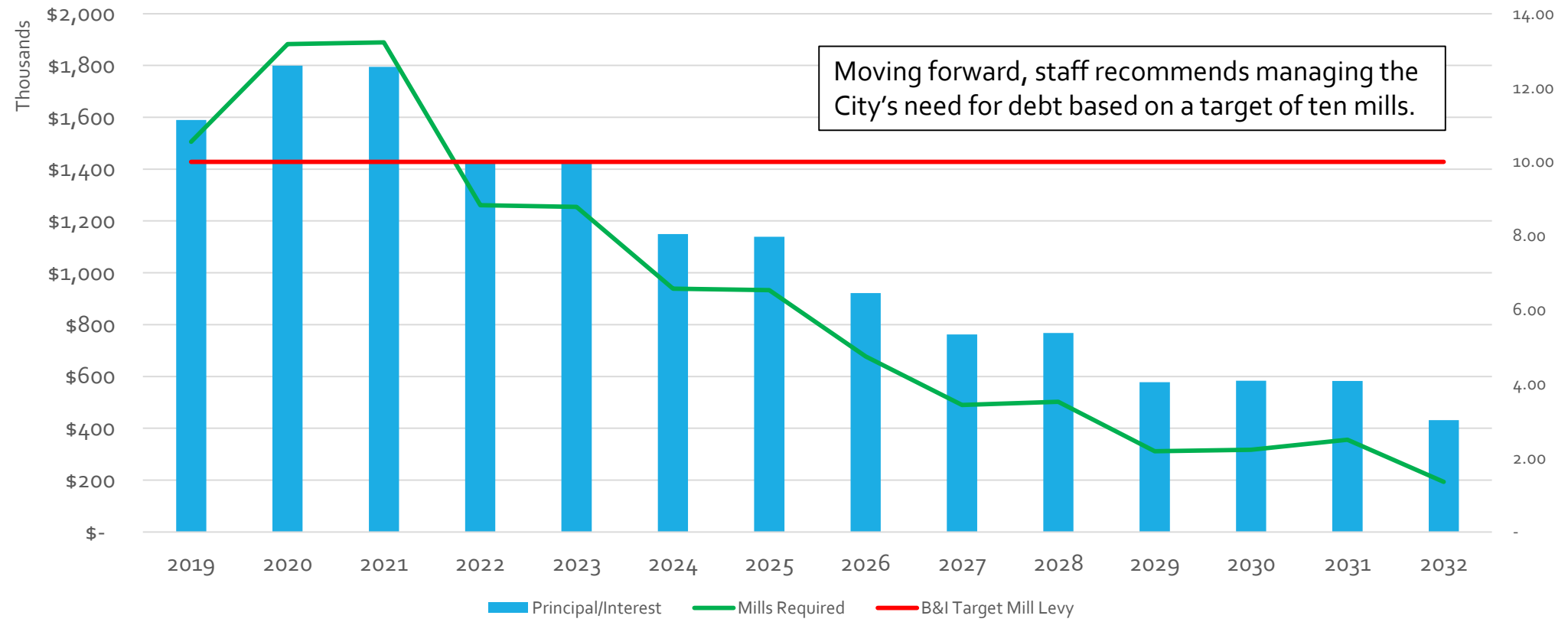

Bond and Interest Fund Questions

- Use cash balance of \$312,000 to mitigate need for shifting revenue from General Fund, or other funds, to cover debt service payments?
- Develop policy to target ten mills for debt service and prudently manage capital outlay around that target?
- Review (and potentially modify) public infrastructure policies for new development?
 - What does the City at-large finance?
 - What does the developer/property owners finance?
 - How long does the City wish to extend financing for public improvements?
 - Will the City charge property owners interest on projects?

General Fund

- The baseline 2020 General Fund is projected to have a \$233,125 deficit.
- The baseline budget does not include any operational expenditure increases except for salaries and benefits:
 - Proposing 3% merit increase and health Insurance premiums are projected to increase 5% with est. maximum cost of \$196,914
- Baseline budget incl. open positions with total est. cost of \$357,072:
 - Patrol Officer (3) - \$197,973
 - Equipment Operator (2) - \$108,456
 - Maintenance Worker (1) - \$50,643

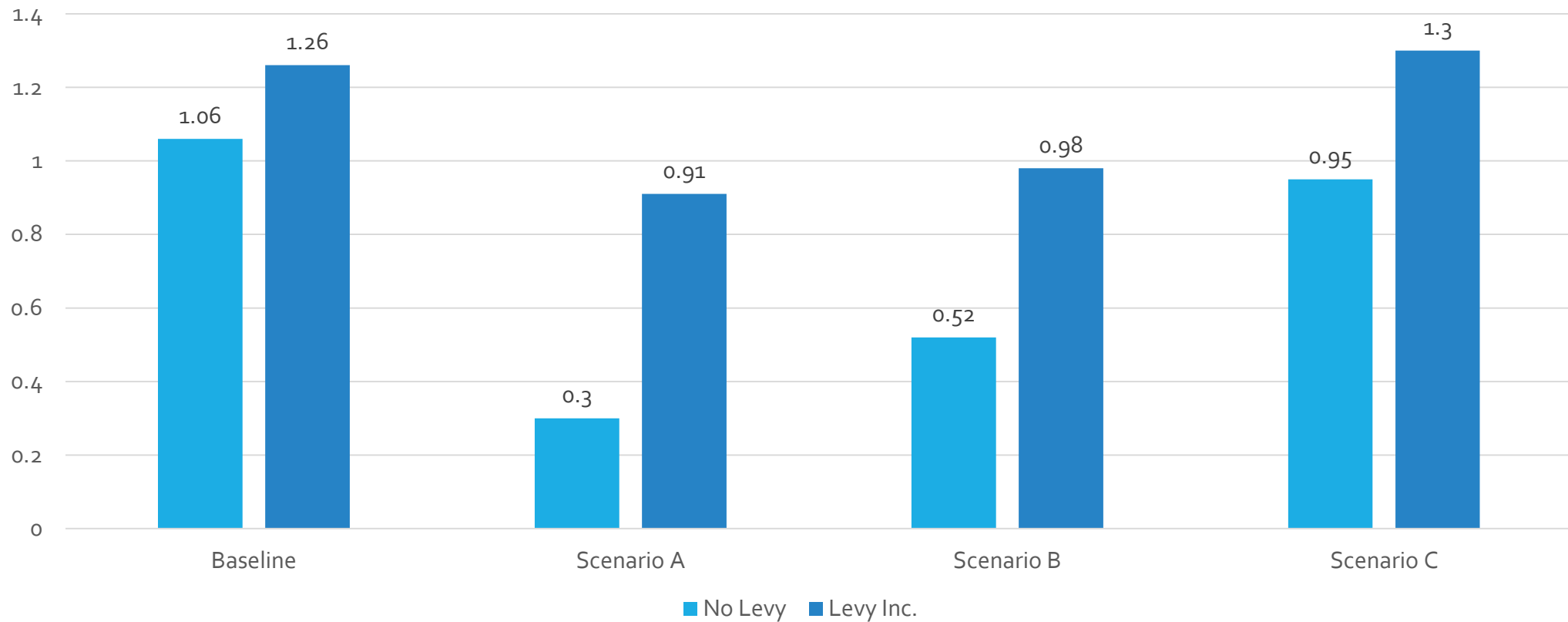

Assessed Valuation

- City's property tax revenue anticipated to increase \$300,000 in 2022.
- Allocating these "new" funds to non-public safety positions will leave approximately \$30,000 for other expenses such as:
 - Vehicle and equipment replacement
 - General operational increases
- Non-public safety position include: Equipment Operators (2), Maintenance Worker (1), and Parks Maintenance Worker (2).
- Scenario requires a mill levy increase to include public safety positions.

General Fund Questions

- Additions to General Fund personnel budgets now or defer until tax revenues increase in 2022?
- Public safety mill levy for police and fire personnel budgets?
- Offsetting expenses to General Fund budget?
- Remove open positions to balance General Fund budget?

Stormwater Fund

- Budget incl. two open Maintenance Worker positions at est. cost of \$101,285.
- Budget would operate with deficit of \$29,700 if all open positions were filled. Fund has a cash balance of \$389,000.
- Is the Commission's desire for the Stormwater Fund to facilitate the construction of major stormwater projects? Or is the desire to focus on operations and maintenance?
- If focus on construction, annual revenue of about \$300,000 is insufficient to cover debt service for a major project. Does the Commission want to discuss an increase to the stormwater fee?

Excess Sales Tax

- Approximately \$349,000 available to allocate to special projects.
- Current process allows staff and other community agencies to submit projects to the Excess Sales Tax Committee for review and recommendation.
- Does the City Commission desire to direct the committee to give special consideration to the allocation of excess sales tax funds to special projects in parks and recreation, or will the funds be available for allocation in other functional areas?
- Will the City Commission consider allocations of excess sales tax funds to maintenance projects and/or vehicle and equipment replacement?

Lake Debt Funds Allocation

- The City Commission has agreed in principle to pre-paying outstanding Lake Debt for Stages 2 and 3; formal vote scheduled in May.
- Pre-payment will provide some flexibility to re-allocate the \$665,000 currently allocated to Lake Debt.
- How does the City Commission desire to reallocate funds currently allocated to Lake Debt payments?
 - Water and sewer infrastructure maintenance?
 - Future payment of Lake Debt?
 - Reduce water and/or sewer rates?
 - Special projects?

Parks Sales Tax

- The City Commission had expressed some interest in pursuing a special sales tax to fund all or a portion of the Parks Master Plan.
- Staff will continue to invest in parks facilities as funds are identified without a specific source of funding.
- Most recently, excess sales tax funds have been used as a source of funding for a variety of projects throughout the park system.
- Does the City Commission have any interest in pursuing a special sales tax to fund implementation of the Parks Master Plan?

Other Considerations

- Not anticipating any rate changes in Water and Sewer Funds.
- Likely rate restructuring in Refuse Fund once recycling is discontinued.
- General Fund cash balance will be reduced in 2019 due to participation in tennis court complex (\$185,000) and Activity Center Roof (\$65,000).
- Tourism Fund cash balance could be reduced in 2019 on community branding initiative and/or Lake Recreational Master Plan.
- Water Fund cash balance will be reduced in 2019 due to anticipated wind turbine decommissioning and demolition (\$300,000).
- Recommendation to delay Police Facility Study until capacity exists in Bond and Interest Fund for construction.
