Commissioner Kelly Tetrick moved that since Pearson Construction has submitted the lowest and best bid of \$179,936.00 for Project No. 609, the City Manager be directed to award the contract to said contractor providing that the company furnish the proper bonds.

Kevin Wishart, Parks and Recreation Director, stated that staff would like to move forward with a composite material fence. He stated that they require less maintenance and have a good warranty.

Commissioner Kelly Tetrick moved to accept the bid from SportsEdge in the amount of \$149,640.77 for materials and Kansas Fencing in the amount of \$29,413.00 for installation and direct the City Manager to sign the contracts.

Commissioner Kendra Wilkinson seconded the motion.

Mayor Bill Young asked if the outfield fence height was being increased.

Mr. Wishart stated that it was being increased to 12 feet.

Commissioner Leon Leachman asked if there would be a home run line.

Mr. Wishart stated that there would be.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

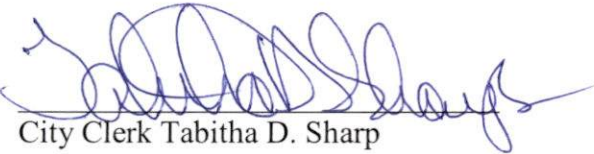
There was no executive session scheduled.

ADJOURNMENT

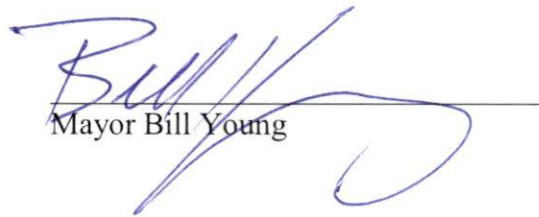
Commissioner Kendra Wilkinson moved to adjourn the meeting at 5 p.m.
