WORK SESSION DISCUSSION ITEMS

PUBLICATION CHARTER ORDINANCE

City Manager David Dillner stated that many cities have moved to utilizing the website as the official space for publications now that newspapers have limited their publication timelines and fewer people are subscribing to those papers. He stated that this ordinance would allow the City to begin utilizing the website once the required sixty days had passed without a sufficient petition from the public.

The City Manager asked if the Commission had any interest in changing the pit bull ordinance.

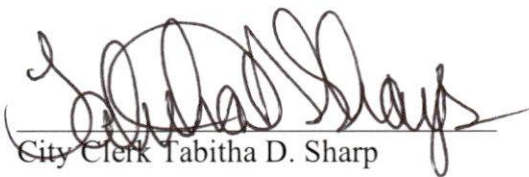
The Commission requested more information from the Animal Control office.
