City Manager David Dillner presented the different financing plan for BG Stadium improvements.

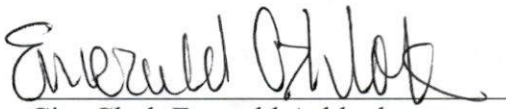
The City Commission discussed which of the three financing plans that they wanted to use.

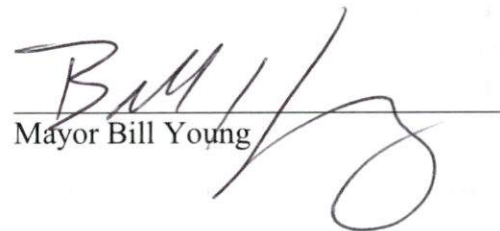
ADJOURNMENT
