CONSENT AGENDA

Approval of City Commission Minutes from August 19, 2024.

Commissioner Syndee Scribner moved to approve the consent agenda.

Commissioner Kelly Tetrick seconded the motion.

OLD BUSINESS

There was no old business.

NEW BUSINESS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.04.010 OF TITLE 10, CHAPTER 10.04 OF EL DORADO MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO TRAFFIC.

Police Chief Mike Holton stated prior to the August 5, 2024 Commission Meeting, several individuals in the community had requested that our ordinance mirror other cities that allow ATVs and UTVs on city streets. City staff created an ordinance allowing ATVs as other cities had done. Once the ordinance was passed, we received quite a few comments that the ordinance only allowed smaller ATVs and did not allow UTVs. Staff have edited the ordinance to allow the UTV as requested by the citizens.

Commissioner Kelly Tetrick moved to approve an Ordinance amending Section 10.04.010 of Title 10, Chapter 10.04 of the El Dorado Municipal Code pertaining to Traffic and incorporating by reference the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities" 50th Edition, with certain omissions, changes, and additions; prescribing additional regulations; providing certain penalties and repealing prior ordinances.

Commissioner Syndee Scribner seconded the motion.

Motion carried 4-0.

CITY COMMISSION AND ADVISORY BOARD UPDATES

Commissioner Kendra Wilkinson stated that the Main Street Board met and discussed Trick or Treat Down Main Street and the upcoming Thankful Thursday event.

CITY MANAGER REPORT

City Manager David Dillner stated that there is a Work Session on September 11th and the topics are Economic Development, Infrastructure Policies, and Street Sales Tax

City Manager Dillner stated that on September 16th the Revenue Neutral Rate and Budget Hearings will be held during the City Commission Meeting at 5:30.

City Manager Dillner stated that Staff has begun to talk about the Legislative Agenda. He stated that there are a couple of items that they would like to advocate for at the upcoming Legislative Session. He stated that the information will be provided to the Commission at an upcoming meeting.

City Manager Dillner stated that there are about 3,500 AMI meters installed, but there are several thousand that need to be replaced.

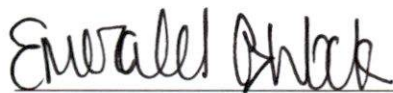
City Manager Dillner stated that the Central Avenue Project is on schedule for the November completion date.

ADJOURNMENT

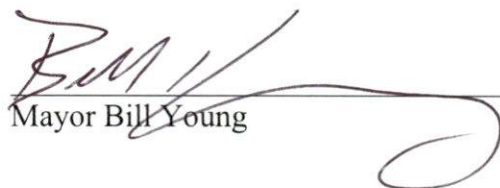
Commissioner moved Kendra Wilkinson to adjourn the meeting at 5:52 p.m.
