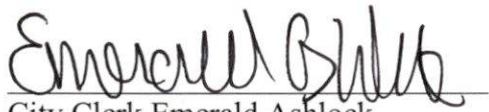

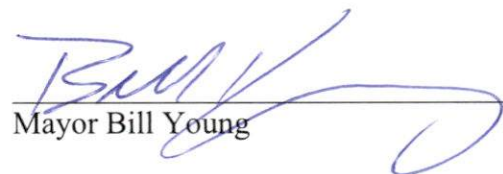
ADJOURNMENT
