The Meeting was called to order by Chairman, Loren Anthony at 5:28 p.m.

The September 16, 2015 meeting minutes were approved as presented.

Kevin Wishart reported on the status of the Park Master Plan and the answers to the questions posed by the board at the September meeting. The board gave its approval to forward the document for the City Commission for review. Kevin will continue to keep the board updated on the status of the plan.

Kevin Wishart reported that communication with representatives from the YMCA continues and that at present there are no additional meetings scheduled. It is anticipated that the next meeting will be held in late November or early December.

Kevin Wishart gave a synopsis of the plans for the upcoming youth basketball season and shared a copy of the flyer that will be distributed through the USD 490 schools. Kevin also shared that the upcoming baseball/softball season will offer both recreation and Wichita Heights league opportunities for ages U8-U12. U14 baseball and softball will be Heights only as registration numbers in this age division do not appear to be sufficient to allow two leagues.

Kevin Wishart gave a report of maintenance projects underway at City parks and recreation facilities. Anthony Heilman suggested that staff prepare a coaches information packet for each sport to be used in the recruitment of new coaches for each season. Kevin indicated that staff would prepare a sample document for review prior to the October meeting.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:28 p.m.
