PUBLIC COMMENT POLICY:

Citizens are encouraged to address the City Commission during regularly scheduled meetings. This policy is intended to provide some guidelines to ensure that all El Dorado citizens have a chance to address the Commission.

1. Each citizen will state their name and address before making comments.
2. There are no residency requirements.
3. Each citizen will have 5 minutes to present his or her comments.
4. An extension of time, if necessary, may be approved but must be by a majority of the City Commission.
5. Comments or questions will be directed only to the City Commission.
6. Citizens will follow the decorum policy.
7. Debate or argument between parties in the audience will not be allowed.
8. Certain legal issues may not be discussed. (Examples include but are not limited to personnel issues, lawsuits, etc.)
9. Violation of this public comment policy will result in the citizen being directed to cease or resume sitting.

3. Sales Tax Advisory Committee Recommendations

BACKGROUND

Andy Waller, Chairperson of the Sales Tax Advisory Committee, will appear before the City Commission to submit the Committee's recommendations on the uncommitted sales tax.

The total sales tax revenue received in 2015 was \$2,610,527.74. The amount of 2015 excess sales tax revenue available for allocation by the Sales Tax Advisory Committee is \$623,725.86. The proposed uses of the uncommitted funds by the Sales Tax Advisory Committee are:

- \$278,306.56 (3.49 mills) for additional property tax reduction
- \$85,000 for the police storage building with the solar energy option
- \$77,000 for the solar lighting projects (\$59,000 for paths and \$18,000 for the Engineering Building)
- \$65,000 for the Disc Golf Course/Cart Path Completion Project (Committee would like this to be contingent on the project being 18 holes completed by a contractor)
- \$35,000 for McDonald Stadium Repairs (No garage)
- \$30,000 for the Arena (Contingent on being built in El Dorado)
- \$30,000 for the Elks Lodge Building (Contingent on Attorney opinion)
- \$20,198.12 for Ball Field Repairs
- \$3,000 for the Main Street Façade Grant

The total allocation recommended is \$623,504.68. The minutes and requests for funding were provided to the Commission for review at the beginning of April.

4. Federal Fund Exchange Program

BACKGROUND

The Federal Fund Exchange Program is a voluntary program that allows local public agencies to trade all or a portion of its federal fund allocations in a specific federal fiscal year with KDOT in exchange for state transportation dollars.

City staff would like to use this funding to cover a portion of the City's expenses on the Paving of Griffith, as well as Bike Path Extensions at the Criss Addition and East Park (Phase 3 Part 1). Currently the City has \$336,049.45 available and Staff would propose that we split that amount amongst the three projects as shown below.

- Paving Griffith (City at Large Costs) \$172,194.81
- Bike Path (Phase 3 Part 1) \$129,866.80
- Bike Path (Criss Addition) \$ 34,255.00

The request for funding must be submitted to KDOT by April 29th, 2016.
