CALL TO ORDER

Vice Mayor Gregg Lewis called the February 28, 2018 Special City Commission meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

ELKS LODGE REQUEST

Roger Cutsinger with the El Dorado Elks Club requested that the City Commission allow the Elks to use the money allocated to them for the construction of a new building on Haverhill to the renovation to a building they are purchasing downtown.

The Commission agreed to discuss approval of the proposal at the next regular meeting on the conditions that the building was purchased in 6 months and that local contractors were used where possible.

OIL MUSEUM MOWING

City Manager David Dillner reviewed the costs for mowing the property for the Oil Museum each year.

The City Commission requested that staff approach the Oil Museum to see if they have a contract and if they would be willing to negotiate.

COURT FEE MONEY

City Clerk Tabitha Sharp and Police Chief Curt Zieman reviewed the court fee program for local organizations. Police Chief Zieman stated that the money could be utilized for the purchase of new equipment and training for the police department.

BLUEPRINT FOR EL DORADO

City Manager David Dillner stated that he is looking at ways to promote private investment. He stated that we would begin to focus on the Downtown, Housing and Industry arenas. He explained how we could develop strategies, better utilize tools and engage our partners to enhance these arenas. He stated that he would be moving forward with the discussion with various community members.
