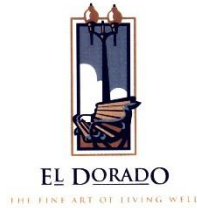

Background: The Educational Facilities Authority of Butler County (EFABC) was formed by the City of El Dorado, Butler Community College, and Unified School District No. 490, in March 2010, for the purpose of facilitating the construction of BG Stadium, and to provide for its continued and ongoing operation and maintenance. Each entity contributed financial resources to the stadium's construction and have also made contributions, both cash and in-kind, to its operations and maintenance since construction was completed.

BG Stadium hosts many athletic events and other activities for each entity, and is available to the general public as a venue for events. The EFABC developed rental rates and provisions so as to provide opportunities to generate revenue from its continued use. As a member of the EFABC, the City has the benefit of renting the facility at the partner rate, which is lower than the rates established for other users who are not partnering entities in the EFABC.

Policy Issue: Should the City of El Dorado continue its participation in the EFABC or should it terminate its involvement in the partnership?

Alternatives: The City Manager has determined the following options exist with respect to this issue (*listed in no particular order*):

- Continue participation in the EFABC as provided in the organization's Cooperation Agreement, By-laws and subsequent other agreements;
- Continue participation in the EFABC, but facilitate the development of a transparent and equitable method of providing for the continued operation and maintenance of BG Stadium; or
- Terminate membership in the EFABC as provided in Section Four of the Cooperation Agreement establishing the organization.

Fiscal Impact: Presently, the cash contribution paid by the City for membership into the EFABC is minimal. The annual fee is established based on use of BG Stadium by each of the three entities. The City of El Dorado uses the facility minimally each year, therefore the City's fee has averaged \$3,938 per year for the last four years.

In addition to the annual cash contribution, the City has provided in-kind contributions to assist with the ongoing operations and maintenance of BG Stadium. The value of these contributions has varied through the years, although last year the City allocated \$19,964 in public assets (such as labor, materials, and equipment) for work projects at BG Stadium. Previous year's in-kind contributions were not well-documented to include this information in the analysis.

The in-kind contributions require the City to allocate resources away from City projects and work to BG Stadium. It is difficult to measure the direct impact to public services from such reallocation of resources. In other words, City projects would receive attention and resources from City departments that are otherwise allocated to maintenance at the stadium, although the actual quantity or specificity of projects cannot be determined.

Legal Review: At my request, City Attorney Ashlyn Lindskog reviewed the Cooperation Agreement and subsequent other EFABC documents and concluded that the City could leave the EFABC by notice by May 15th. The Cooperation Agreement and By-laws do not obligation the City to spending public funds on EFABC projects, although Section 5 of the Cooperation Agreement states that the partners will consult with one another in good faith towards the development of an annual operating budget for each succeeding year.

Participation in this budget process would not necessarily obligate the City to appropriate funds, but does provide an opportunity for the City to participate in the budgeting process and may signify intent to participate in operating expenses agreed to in the development of the annual budget. It is my understanding that the entities have not facilitated the aforementioned budget process in recent years.

Under the terms of the Cooperation Agreement, the City cannot terminate its membership in the EFABC if the EFABC has any outstanding debt obligations. As of the writing of this memorandum, I am unaware of any outstanding debt obligations the EFABC is responsible for that would prevent the City from exercising its right to terminate its membership. The City's termination of the Cooperation Agreement would effectively terminate the EFABC.

Trade-offs: BG Stadium currently has an economic impact to the community. The economic impact from the stadium is not likely to be affected by the City's continued participation in the EFABC. This is largely due to the fact that many of the events can and will still be held at the stadium within the context of existing agreements. Many of the events and activities held at BG Stadium were beyond the scope of the City, and will continue regardless of the City's continued involvement.

Perhaps the most critical trade-off is the potential damage to political partnerships with Butler Community College and USD 490. It is difficult to assess the intangible affect leaving the EFABC would have on the City's existing partnerships with these entities, although it is reasonable to conclude that these relationships, and potentially relationships with other interested parties, would experience difficulties in the foreseeable future if the City elects to terminate its participation.

Staff Recommendation: The City Manager recommends continuing participation in the EFABC, but with a discussion with partnering entities to develop an improved process for approving and accounting for maintenance projects and the financing of such projects with cash and in-kind contributions. This process could be best facilitated as part of a more formal budget process between the partnering entities. The partnership serves as a good example of intergovernmental partnership, and should be periodically reviewed to determine if there are any areas that could be improved upon.

To be sure, the primary concerns of the City Commission seem to be related to ensuring that each entity has an equitable interest in the ongoing maintenance projects. This can easily be addressed with a more refined framework for identifying projects and developing and approving the finance plan associated with such projects.

Additionally, another concern seems to be focused on the significant expenses related to future capital improvement projects, most notably the track and turf replacement that will be necessary in the next few years. The City Manager and City Attorney agree that the City is not obligated to participate financially in such future capital projects. The EFABC may request financial assistance from the City, but the governing body will have to approval any financial participation in these projects. The EFABC will have to raise funds privately if the City does not appropriate funds for these or other future projects.

Commission Actions: The City Commission has the following options with respect to this issue (*listed in no particular order*):

- **Continue participation in the EFABC as provided in the organization's Cooperation Agreement, By-laws and subsequent other agreements.** This option requires no action from the City Commission and would preserve the current participation status in the EFABC.
- **Direct the City Manager to work with representatives from Butler Community College and USD 490 to development an improved, transparent and equitable method of providing for the continued operation and maintenance of BG Stadium.** A formal process may be developed between the participating entities to clarify how operational and maintenance projects will be accounted for, to include cash and in-kind contributions, and an approval and reporting mechanism that ensures transparency of such projects and expenditures to each governing entity and the general public.
- **Elect to terminate membership in the EFABC as provided in Section Four of the Cooperation Agreement establishing the organization.** This option requires the City to send a letter to each of the other entities on or before May 15th expressing the City's intent to terminate its involvement in the Cooperation Agreement. The City's participation would become effective the following June 30th.
- **Request additional information from the City Manager.** The City Manager will collect such other information as may be necessary to assist the City Commission in making an informed decision on this matter. The City Commission will need to specify the information desired if this option is selected.

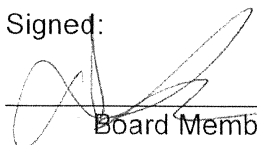

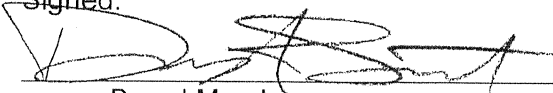

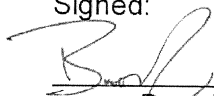
